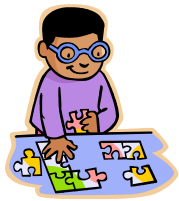
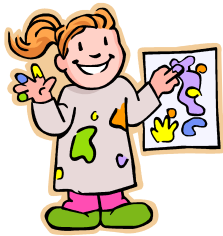


A Day in the Life at Little Learners

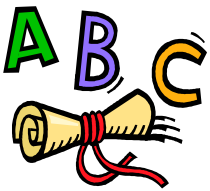
